## **SUNNYVALE SEEKS COMMUNITY INPUT ON LAWRENCE STATION AREA PLAN**

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The City of Sunnyvale will host a community outreach meeting to gain input from the public regarding the proposed Lawrence Station Area Plan. The two-hour meeting will begin at 6:30 p.m., Wednesday, February 16 at the Sunnyvale Public Library, 665 W. Olive Ave.

Lawrence Station Transit Village represents a unique opportunity to plan for the future using smart-growth concepts by creating a specific plan – the Station Area Plan – to bring higher density residential, employment and neighborhood commercial uses to an existing multi-modal area. The station's location gives tremendous opportunity for increased transit use in conjunction with a county expressway. This opportunity allows the City of Sunnyvale to work closely with the City of Santa Clara in developing a plan that will be regional in scope and provides exciting opportunities for the future of the area.

The identified study area is located within the jurisdictions of Sunnyvale and Santa Clara, with the focus being on the development potential within Sunnyvale.

Transportation agencies will play an important role as key stakeholders. Partner agencies include: City of Santa Clara, Valley Transportation Authority, Caltrain and the County of Santa Clara. BMS Design Group leads the consultant team.
