## **PATENT EXPERT COMES TO SUNNYVALE PUBLIC LIBRARY**

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – Are you interested in how to obtain a patent – without hiring an attorney? Would you like to better understand the patenting process? Then don't miss this chance to see David Pressman, author of the bestselling guide *Patent It Yourself*, when he gives a talk at the Sunnyvale Public Library on Saturday, April 9, at 2 p.m.

Pressman has more than 40 years of experience in the patent profession, as a patent examiner for the U.S. Patent Office, a patent attorney and university instructor. He'll talk about the ins and outs of "patenting it yourself," and answer questions from the audience. The 15<sup>th</sup> edition of Pressman's *Patent It Yourself* comes out in early April, and 300,000 copies have already been sold.
