SUNNYVALE HEALTH & SAFETY FAIR SET FOR APRIL 30

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – Celebrate wellness and bring the family to the City of Sunnyvale’s 2011 Health & Safety Fair for an afternoon of fun activities, learning opportunities and entertainment. Sunnyvale is once again teaming up with local groups to inform residents about health and safety services in the community. Admission is free and the fair takes place Saturday, April 30, at Columbia Middle School, 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Free adult health screenings, including diabetes, cholesterol, blood pressure, body mass index and vision testing will be provided by health service technicians. Children can climb the rock wall, play in the bounce house, participate in a US Soccer Foundation Skills Clinic and learn about wellness as they play games and win prizes. They’ll also have a chance to explore a variety of Department of Public Safety vehicles including fire rigs, squad cars and the Stanford Life Flight rescue helicopter. Free bike safety tune ups will also be provided. There will also be free dental resources and oral health checks for children.

You can also have your car’s child safety seats checked for proper fit. Appointments are required, and can be made by calling (408) 730-7176. Information about child safety and injury prevention will be offered.

More than 50 exhibitors will be present. There will be food, music, activities and entertainment for the entire family.
