## **NIGHTTIME RESURFACING ON EL CAMINO TO START IN LATE AUGUST**

**Expect rolling lane closures in southbound lane, ramp closures  
and nighttime construction noises**

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be starting a 90-day, nighttime resurfacing project on southbound El Camino Real in late August, but Sunnyvale residents and commuters should expect to see signs posted as early as this week.

The three-month resurfacing project will be in the southbound direction of El Camino Real, starting at Lawrence Expressway in Santa Clara, running through Sunnyvale and ending after State Route 85 in Mountain View at Bay Street. Work will include grinding and placing hot mix asphalt on sections of the road from 10 p.m. until 7 a.m. on weekdays. Ramp closures can be expected during the evening construction hours on weekdays and may be extended into later morning hours on weekends. Message signs about the construction, including closures and detours, will be visible to traffic along the route.

The northbound paving of El Camino Real is currently scheduled to start in summer 2013. Both construction projects aim to minimize road deterioration and improve the safety of this major thoroughfare by extending the life of the existing pavement.
