SUNNYVALE ENACTS SMOKING BAN

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The City of Sunnyvale has joined the many cities that have enacted bans on smoking in public places. City Council approved a ban on smoking in public parks, with the exception of golf courses, and allowed the City Manager to designate City property as non-smoking. The ordinance was approved by Council at their April 3 meeting.

In June 2011, the City of Sunnyvale received a \$76,292 grant from Santa Clara County Public Health Department, Communities Putting Prevention to Work program, to research and consider adopting more restrictive smoking policies in an effort to reduce the public's exposure to secondhand smoke.
