SUNNYVALE SEEKS ADVISORY GROUP MEMBERS

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The City of Sunnyvale is inviting applications from Sunnyvale and Santa Clara residents, business representatives and property owners to serve on the Lawrence Station Area Plan Citizens Advisory Group. The advisory group is important in performing community education, discussion and policy deliberation.

Lawrence Station Transit Village represents a unique opportunity to plan for the future using smart-growth concepts by creating a specific plan – the Station Area Plan – to bring higher density residential, employment and neighborhood commercial uses to an existing multi-modal area. The station's location gives tremendous opportunity for increased transit use in conjunction with a county expressway. This opportunity allows the City of Sunnyvale to work closely with the City of Santa Clara in developing a plan that will be regional in scope and provides exciting opportunities for the future of the area.

The identified study area is located within the jurisdictions of Sunnyvale and Santa Clara, with the focus being on the development potential within Sunnyvale.

Transportation agencies will play an important role as key stakeholders.

Those community members selected to be members of the advisory group will meet about once a month for 12 months, beginning in June or July.
