SUNNYVALE RECEIVES GFOA BUDGET PRESENTATION AWARD

Award given to the City for 22 consecutive years

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The City of Sunnyvale has been notified that it has received the Distinguished Budget Presentation Award from the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for the City's Fiscal Year 2011/12 adopted budget. GFOA is the professional association of state and local finance officers in the United States and Canada.

This was the 22nd consecutive year the City has received this prestigious award. It is the highest form of recognition in governmental budgeting, and it reflects the commitment of the governing body and staff to meeting both the guidelines established by the National Advisory Council on State and Local Budgeting and GFOA's best practices on budgeting. In qualifying for the award, the City's budget document was judged to be proficient as a policy document, a financial plan, an operations guide and a communications device.
