SUNNYVALE PUBLIC SAFETY ENDS BANK ROBBERY SPREE

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – Sunnyvale Department of Public Safety (DPS) investigators have arrested a Lodi, Calif., man in connection with two bank robberies in the South Bay. Adam Kiedrowski, 28, was taken into custody at a motel in San Jose on Tuesday afternoon, September 25.

The investigation began on September 5 after an unknown male suspect entered a U.S. Bank in Sunnyvale, presented a demand note to a teller and indicated that he was armed by showing a black semi-automatic pistol in his waistband. After getting the cash, the suspect exited the bank and was seen on foot headed eastbound toward Hollenbeck Avenue.

Sunnyvale Detectives and Crime Scene Investigators gathered physical evidence at the scene that matched Kiedrowski, and officers took him into custody with assistance from the San Jose Police Department. Evidence linking Kiedrowski to the bank robbery in Sunnyvale was located in his motel room, and he was booked into the Santa Clara County jail on armed robbery charges.

Based on additional information and interviews, it was determined that Kiedrowski was also responsible for the armed bank robbery at another U.S. Bank in San Jose on August 28 – just eight days before the Sunnyvale robbery.
