CITY OF SUNNYVALE NAMES COMMUNITY AWARD WINNERS

Award presentations to be made at September 7 State of the City Celebration

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The City of Sunnyvale has announced the winners of the annual Community Awards program. The Mayor and Councilmembers will honor the awardees at the City’s upcoming State of the City Celebration.

Award nominations were accepted from the community this spring and were reviewed by a panel of former Community Awards winners. This year’s awardees are: Ed Walzer, Outstanding Community Volunteer; Alan Moo, Outstanding Contribution to the Arts; Shanam Saini, Outstanding Businessperson of the Year; Michelle Edgecumbe, Outstanding Educator; Safe Routes to School Site Coordinators, Outstanding Environmental Achievement; Denzel Campos, Outstanding High School Senior; and Patricia Castillo, Distinguished Resident of the Year.

Mayor Anthony “Tony” Spitaleri will present the special Mayor’s Award of Excellence at the State of the City Celebration. By tradition, this award winner is not named until the ceremony.

Sunnyvale’s State of the City Celebration will take place from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m., Saturday, September 7 at Plaza del Sol, located at 200 W. Evelyn Ave.

The Mayor will deliver his State of the City address at 11 a.m. followed by the Community Awards presentations and performances from local musical and dance groups. Performers include Columbia Middle School Band, Sunnyvale Community Players, PAMPA Dance academy and several other local youth performers.

During the event, Frances Street will be closed between W. Evelyn Ave. and Capella Way and food truck fare will be available along Frances from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Attendees are encouraged to arrive early to allow time for parking at the following recommended locations:

- Plaza del Sol– Free parking in the underground garage with waived restrictions for the event. Enter at the west end of the Plaza.
- Sunnyvale Caltrain Station – Parking is available for a fee across the street from Plaza del Sol but the cost is waived for vehicles with a disabled CA license plate or displayed placard.
- Macy's 4-story Garage – Free parking with a four-hour parking restriction. This parking lot located at Washington Ave. and Sunnyvale Ave.
