PeninsulaWorks Logo and Website Retired

PeninsulaWorks, a brand known throughout San Mateo County since 2000, will be formally retired July 1 and replaced with the NOVA name and logo.

NOVA, the federally funded workforce development agency that has served a consortium of cities in northern Santa Clara County since 1982, proudly welcomed San Mateo County to the NOVA Consortium in July 2015. For the past year, services have been provided at job centers in San Mateo and Menlo Park under the PeninsulaWorks name. With this upcoming change, services will continue uninterrupted at these same locations, but under the NOVA Job Center moniker.

When this change takes effect on July 1, job-seeker customers and businesses will be able to locate all of the services provided by the NOVA consortium and its contractors through a single portal, the NOVA website, novaworks.org. This will streamline access to the wide range of exceptional services that are available to customers where they live and work in the region, as well as promote enhanced coordination among the providers at the three job center sites. "Through the NOVA brand, job seekers and employers in the region will be able to easily identify and locate the network of services they need, when and where they need them, resulting in a better customer experience and outcome," stated NOVA Executive Director Kris Stadelman.

Uniting the NOVA workforce development system under the NOVA brand also supports the spirit and intent of the new federal authorizing legislation Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) that fosters improved customer service and satisfaction, greater efficiencies and increased regional collaboration.

The NOVA Job Center in Sunnyvale will continue to provide customer-focused services to individuals seeking re-employment, as well as to local businesses seeking professional solutions for human resource issues.
