## **HOMICIDE SUSPECT SHOT AND KILLED IN SUNNYVALE**

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – At about 7:30 a.m. this morning (October 6, 2011), Sunnyvale Department of Public Safety (DPS) officers responded to the 900 block of Lorne Way on a report of a shooting that had just occurred. Upon arrival, officers determined members of the Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office were involved in the incident.

Following county protocols, Sunnyvale DPS has assumed responsibility for the investigation of the shooting because it occurred within the City's jurisdiction. At this time, DPS detectives are in the initial stages of their investigation. The officers involved in the shooting are being interviewed by detectives. Crime scene investigators and members of the Santa Clara County Crime Lab are processing the scene where the suspect was shot after pointing a hand gun at the officers.

The suspect has been identified as Shareef Allman, 49, a San Jose resident. The Santa Clara County Coroner's Office confirmed the identity of the suspect through his fingerprints. This is the same suspect who was the subject of an intensive search after he reportedly shot several employees at the cement plant near Cupertino

yesterday morning and an attempted carjacking and shooting near Homestead Road on the Cupertino-Sunnyvale border.
