COMMUNITY MEETINGS SET ON SUNNYVALE UTILITY RATE INCREASES

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – Community outreach meetings have been scheduled by the City of Sunnyvale to share information regarding proposed utility rate increases. The proposed increases would be 18 percent for water, 5½ percent for wastewater and 6 percent for solid waste. A public hearing on the proposed rates will be held by City Council at 7 p.m., Tuesday, June 14, in Council Chambers.

Prior to the public hearing, three community outreach meetings will be held by the City. The first two are to discuss residential rates, while the final meeting will be focused on business rates. The meetings are scheduled for:

- 6:30 p.m. Thursday, May 19, in Council Chambers, 456 W. Olive Ave.
- 10 a.m. Saturday, May 21, in Council Chambers, 456 W. Olive Ave.
- 9 a.m. Tuesday, May 24, at the SMaRT Station, 301 Carl Road
