EVELYN RAMP TO MATHILDA AVENUE REOPENS

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The ramp from westbound Evelyn Avenue to northbound Mathilda Avenue in downtown Sunnyvale has reopened after a closure of several months. Although the ramp is now open, there will be continued intermittent closures of the ramp as construction continues.

The ramp was shut down as part of the Mathilda Bridge Project. This \$25 million project will result in a wider bridge, improved sidewalks and pedestrian ramps, and a completely redesigned exit ramp from southbound Mathilda Avenue to Evelyn Avenue which, for the first time, will allow motorists to exit either to the east or west onto Evelyn Avenue. The Mathilda Bridge spans both Evelyn Avenue and the Caltrain right-of-way, and is a major north-south route through Sunnyvale.

The Mathilda Bridge project is on schedule for completion in January 2012.
