MINIMUM WAGE INCREASES TO \$15 IN SUNNYVALE JAN. 1, 2018

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – Effective Monday, Jan. 1, 2018, the new minimum wage rate in Sunnyvale will be 15 dollars per hour.

In 2016, the Sunnyvale City Council adopted an ordinance increasing Sunnyvale’s minimum wage per the following schedule:

- \$11.00 on July 1, 2016
- \$13.00 on January 1, 2017
- \$15.00 on January 1, 2018

The ordinance includes an annual adjustment based on inflation starting on Jan. 1, 2019, and every Jan. 1 thereafter. Any potential increase will correspond to the prior year's Consumer Price Index based on the San Francisco-Oakland-San Jose regional index as reported by the U.S. Department of Labor's Bureau of Labor Statistics.
