CITY OF SUNNYVALE NAMES COMMUNITY AWARD WINNERS

Award presentations to be made at Sept. 15 State of the City Celebration

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The City of Sunnyvale has announced the winners of the annual Community Awards program. The Mayor and Councilmembers will honor the awardees at the City's State of the City Celebration on Saturday, Sept. 15.

This year's awardees are: Sunnyvale Community Players, Contribution to the Arts; Alex Ha (from Lakewood Elementary School), Educator of the Year; Melissa Lee (from Fremont High School), High School Student of the Year; Project Revive (Homestead High School Future Business Leaders of America), Environmental Achievement; Sunnyvale Martial Arts Academy, Business of the Year; and Tara Martin-Milius, Distinguished Resident of the Year. Award nominations were accepted from the community this summer and reviewed by a panel of former Community Awards winners.

Mayor Glenn Hendricks will present the special Mayor's Award of Excellence at the State of the City Celebration. By tradition, this award winner is not named until the ceremony.

Sunnyvale's State of the City Celebration will take place from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Saturday, Sept. 15 on Murphy Avenue in downtown Sunnyvale. The Mayor will deliver his State of the City address at 10:30 a.m. followed by the Community Awards presentations.
