APPLICATIONS DUE APRIL 19 FOR ANNUAL COMMUNITY GRANTS

Funds help sponsor local community events and activities

SUNNYVALE, Calif. – The City of Sunnyvale is accepting applications for its annual Community Events and Neighborhood Grant program to support events and projects that will take place between July 2019 and June 2020. Neighborhood Grant recipients are eligible for up to \$1,000. Community Grant recipients can receive up to 40 percent of their expenses.

Organizations and neighborhoods have used grant funds to support a variety of community-building events and activities such as neighborhood block parties, barbeques, and garage sales; local National Night Out and Bike to Work events; summer music festivals; and the Holiday Tree Lighting ceremony in downtown Sunnyvale. To be eligible, groups must be either:

- A nonprofit planning to host a community event in Sunnyvale for at least 500 people or,
- A neighborhood group organizing activities to increase community engagement and improve the quality of life in their neighborhood.

The City will consider all funding requests as part of a competitive application process and the City Council will determine recipients in June 2019. All applications are due by April 19, 2019 by 5 p.m. Applications and guidelines for each grant program are available on the City's website at the links below.
