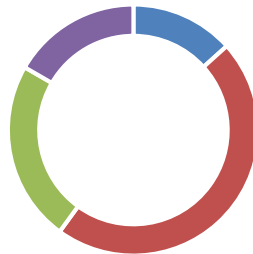


Do you think the City's 12.5% inclusionary requirement for for-sale housing should continue, or should it be changed?



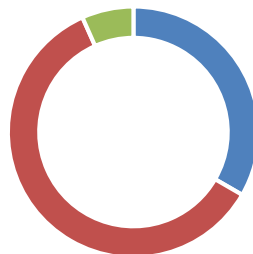

■ No rental inclusionary ■ Yes: 15% ■ Yes: Greater than 15% ■ Yes: But less than 15%

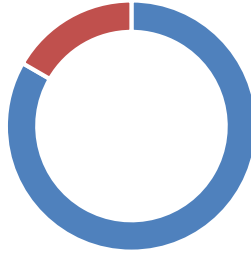
Should City policy include a preference for on-site construction of inclusion housing versus payment of in-lieu fees?
