

**NEW PARK PROJECT, CONSTRUCTION BEGINNING NOV. 9, 2020**

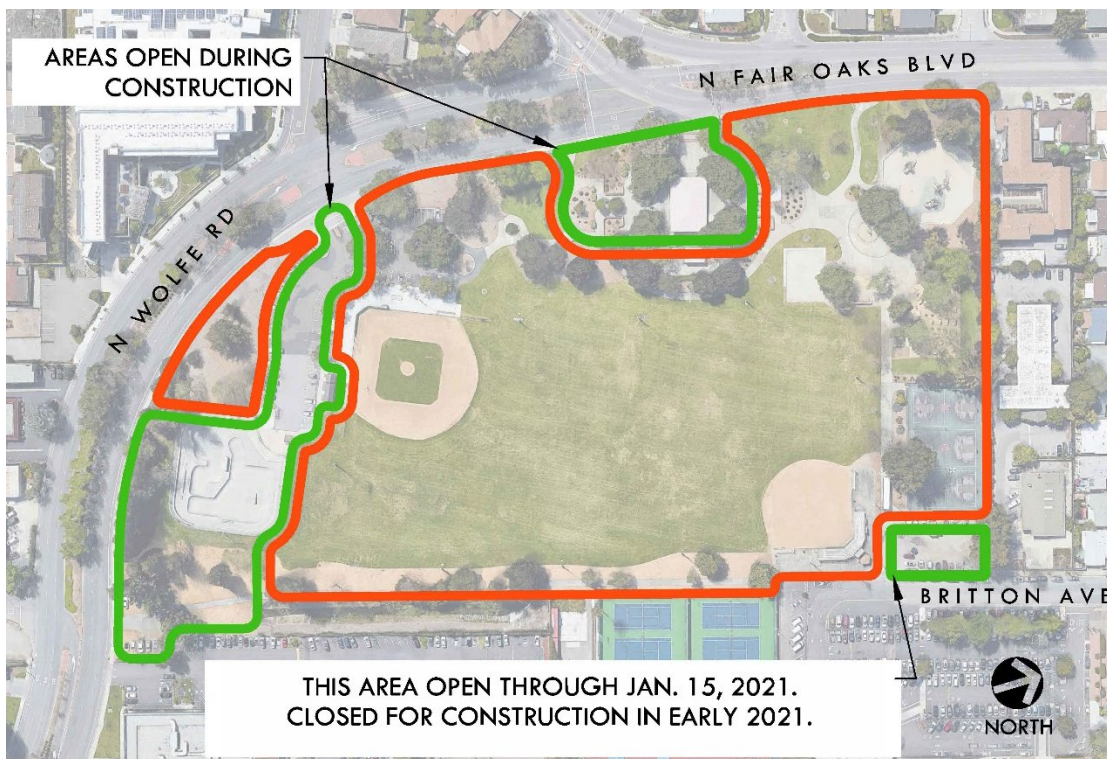
Work to renovate Fair Oaks Park will begin Nov. 9. Following construction, the park will have:

- An inclusive playground designed by the Magical Bridge Foundation
- Multiple sports fields for cricket, soccer, baseball and softball with synthetic turf for year-round use and specialized lighting for nighttime play
- Three basketball courts
- A dog park with areas for small and large dogs
- Picnic areas
- New restrooms and parking areas

**PARK CLOSURES:** There will be limited access to certain areas of the park beginning Nov. 9. The map below shows areas of the park that will remain open (green) and closed (red) during construction. The park building, skate park, and restrooms and parking adjacent to the skate park will be open throughout construction. Access to the rest of the park will be closed.

**TEMPORARY ACCESS:**

The **unimproved parking lot off Britton Ave. will remain open until at least Jan. 15, 2021.** After this, the City will close this area to complete the construction work. The area will then remain closed for the duration of the project. The City will provide periodic updates about the work schedule and planned closures for this area.
