- All volunteers, whether recruited by the Artist or provided by the City of Sunnyvale, must be registered through the City's Volunteer Services program.

As required by law, all volunteers (ages 18+) must pass DOJ background check (fingerprinting) to work with children.

Volunteers receive a commemorative T-shirt to be worn during the event. All volunteers receive a snack during their shift. All-day volunteers also receive a free lunch.

Please be as accurate as possible when requesting volunteers, as extra volunteers beyond those requested on this application may not be available on event day.

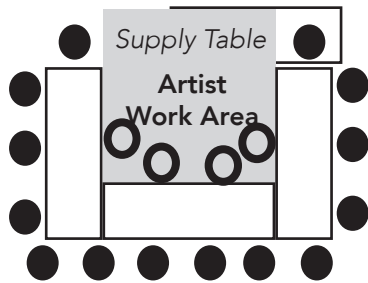

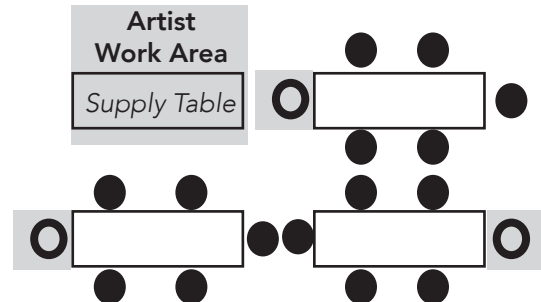

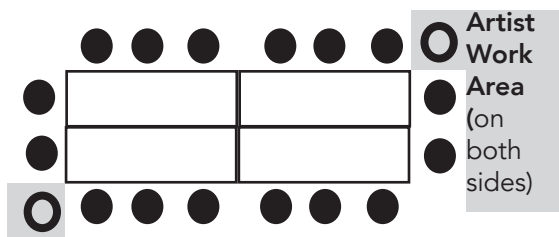
Workshop Participant seating area
