Who can participate? Sunnyvale Public Library card holders, ages 18 and up.

How long does the contest run? Submissions accepted March 1 to 31, 2020. Winner announced in April.

How do I participate? Bring in your original art, along with a completed submission form to the Information Desk in the Sunnyvale Public Library, 665 W. Olive Ave.

- Artwork must be 2 ¾” by 8 ½” on paper no thicker than 3/8” (template attached)
- All mediums accepted, provided they fit the required dimensions.

Judging Criteria:

1. Interpretation of theme
2. Originality
3. Creativity
4. Artistic merit

Bring in your original artwork to the Library’s Information Desk anytime between March 1 and March 31, 2020. A signed and completed submission form must accompany the artwork. Winner will be announced in early April.

Entry Requirements:

1. Only one entry per person
2. All entries must be accompanied by this signed and completed form
3. You must be a Sunnyvale Public Library card holder, age 18 or older
4. Artwork must be 100% produced by the contestant
5. Artwork must be a two-dimensional work, sized 2 ¾ inches by 8 ½ inches, or use the template provided. *All mediums accepted, provided they fit the required dimensions.
