

Re: Sunnyvale Mobile Home MOU Compliance Committee Now Accepting Applications

In late 2021, the City of Sunnyvale established a new mobile home park memorandum of understanding ("MOU") to help stabilize space rent and resale prices of owner-occupied mobile homes in Sunnyvale.

As part of the new MOU, the City Council approved creation of a new oversight committee comprised of mobile home park residents (those who **own** a mobile home in Sunnyvale) and mobile home park owners to ensure the MOU is being implemented in a fair and successful manner.

We are now accepting applications for a seat on the MOU Compliance Committee

("MCC"). This committee will allow one mobile home resident per park to serve on the committee for a term of five years. Meetings will be held no less than two times per year. We highly encourage residents to consider applying for a seat, to ensure your mobile home park is represented on the MCC.
